

Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The City of Port Neches will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 0.95 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax rate calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on September 3, 2009 at 4:00 PM at Port Neches City Hall, 634 Avenue C, Port Neches, Texas.

The second public hearing will be held on September 10, 2009 at 4:00 PM at Port Neches City Hall, 634 Avenue C, Port Neches, Texas.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in City of Port Neches last year was \$114,145. Based on last year's tax rate of \$0.699500 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$798.44.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in City of Port Neches this year is \$115,899. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$0.692950 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$0.699500 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$810.71.
